The Project

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) has determined that the Glenn Highway/Muldoon Road interchange needs to be upgraded to accommodate current and future needs. The purpose of the project is to increase safety and circulation for both cars and non-motorized traffic and to make it easier for freight trucks to travel through the interchange. The goal is to develop and implement a long term solution to address vehicle and pedestrian traffic concerns within the interchange area.

Join DOT&PF and DOWL HKM to express your opinions and concerns and to learn about potential safety and circulation improvements for the interchange at a public meeting on Wednesday, April 24 at Bartlett High School.

DOT&PF and its consultant, DOWL HKM, have begun work on the Glenn Highway and Muldoon Road Interchange Improvements and will be performing preliminary scoping efforts that will identify alternatives that may move forward into future environmental documentation, design, and construction phases. Elements of this project include public and agency scoping, preliminary environmental and engineering services, a noise analysis, and traffic capacity and safety analyses.
